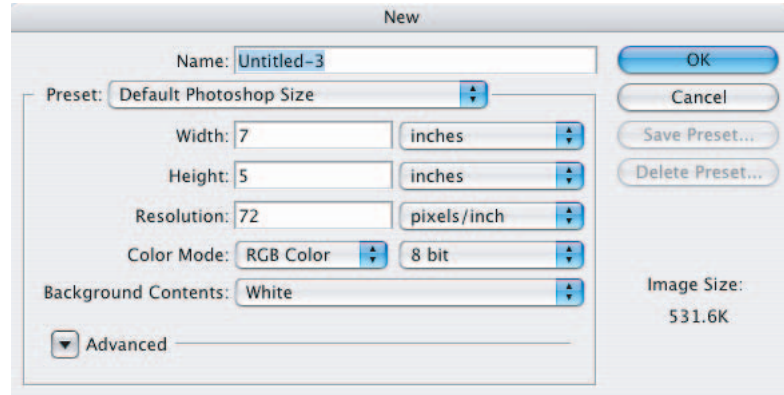


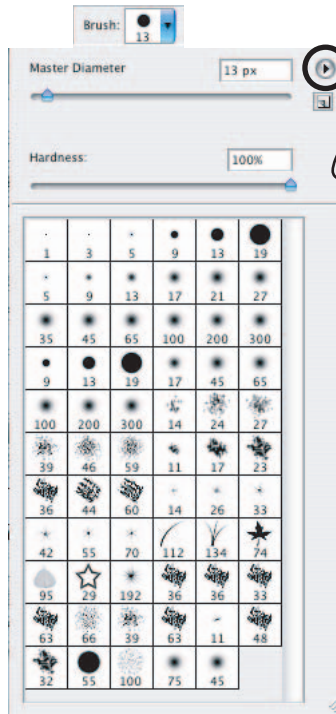
# Painting in Photoshop

Open Photoshop.  
Go to FILE to NEW.  
Choose DEFAULT PHOTOSHOP SIZE

7" x 5"  
72 pixels per inch  
RGB color  
White background



Choose the BRUSH tool from the tools.  
Notice the options in the options bar:  
From here you can change the brush shape and size,  
color mode and opacity.

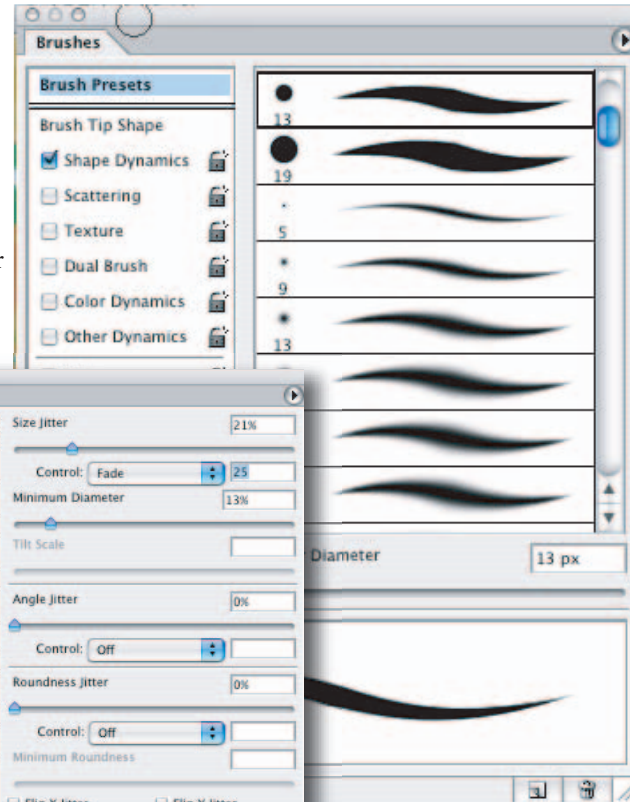


Click on the BRUSH icon to choose a pre-defined brush shape.  
You may also change the SIZE using the DIAMETER slider, or make a softer-edged brush by adjusting the HARDNESS slider.

More brushes can be loaded from the library by clicking the little arrow.

Look at the FAR RIGHT SIDE of the OPTIONS bar for the BRUSHES tab.  
Click on the tab to show the menu. You may drag the BRUSHES palette away from the options bar by clicking on and dragging the little tab.

This lets you change the other dynamics of the brushes...



Single-click the FOREGROUND color (the orange block above) or use the COLOR palette to change the painting color.  
(go to WINDOW/COLOR to see it if its not showing).
